## OYSTER Reefs at Bayview Park

We are still waiting on our Army Corps of Engineers permit. We would like to host an oyster bagging and reef building event December 17th at Bayview Park (*if we get our permit next week.*) The volunteer shifts will be 8am-11am and 11am-2pm. The Offer Your Shell To Enhance Restoration (OYSTER) Project at Bayview Park is a cooperative effort between Clean & Green, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), City of Pensacola, Southern Company (Gulf Power) and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation supported by our local partners. The project seeks to collect oyster shell from local restaurant partners to be used as substrate to restore 22 oyster reefs in Bayou Texar.
